


### 1. Demographic trends:

**ds:** Europe's populations are ageing fast as a result of low birth rates and rising life expectancy. The number of people aged 65 and over relative to people of working age is expected to double by 2060.



### 2. Employment:

Although the typical pensionable age is 65 years, the average exit age from the labour force in 2009 was about 61.5 years, ranging from just under 59 to just over 65.








QB3. And thinking about the age when one stops being regarded as "young" at what age would you say that happens?


